

Privacy Policy

RONAL AG, Lerchenbühl 3, 4624 Härkingen, Switzerland, and its subsidiaries ("**RONAL**"), is committed to protecting your personal data and collect, process and use your personal data exclusively in accordance with the data protection principles described below.

The company responsible for the operation of this website ("**Website**") is APP-TECH S.R.L., a group entity of RONAL with its registered seat at Via Levico 6, 35035 Mestrino, Italy ("**APP-TECH**", "**we**" or "**us**"). On this purely informational Website up-to-date information on APP-TECH and the products and services offered by APP-TECH is presented to you. When you visit this Website, personal data may under certain circumstances be collected and stored by us. We will explain this to you in detail below:

1. In General

- 1.1. Personal data is all information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("**Data**"). This includes for example your name, your phone number and your postal and e-mail address.
- 1.2. We generally do not collect, process and use any of your Data if you visit our Website for informational purposes only.
- 1.3. If you use our contact form or contact us by other means, the Data entered will be stored by us for processing your enquiry (as well as any follow-up questions). This Data will not be passed on to third parties without your consent.

The Data entered by you in the contact form or otherwise disclosed will remain with us until

- you will request its deletion,
- you withdraw your consent to storage,
- or the purpose for the Data storage is omitted (e.g. after completed processing of your request).

Legal retention periods remain unaffected by this.

The Data which you enter in the contact form or which you provide to us by contacting us otherwise will be processed on the basis of your consent in order to answer your enquiry. You can revoke this consent at any time - informal message by e-mail to dataprivacy.it@ronalgroup.com or by letter to the contact address mentioned under point 5 is sufficient.

The legality of the data processing operations carried out until the revocation remains unaffected by the revocation.

2. Cookies and Plugins

- 2.1. On our Website, we use so-called "Cookies". Cookies are small text files that are stored via your web browser on your hard disk. Cookies do not contain any information that could identify the individual user personally. You can set your browser not to save any Cookies of this Website and you may also delete Cookies automatically or manually. However, please note that by doing so you may not or no longer be able to use all the provided functions of our Website in full.
- 2.2. We also use a plugin on our website to send emails. If you click on the corresponding button, your personal email program opens and a connection to the server of your email provider is established. We have no influence on the data collected by your email provider and refer you in this regard to the corresponding data protection information of the provider used by you in individual cases.

3. Data Transfer and Use of Data by Third Parties

- 3.1. We will not transfer your Data to any third parties unless we are (i) legally required to do so or (ii) you have given your consent thereto. The following provisions remain reserved.
- 3.2. For the maintenance of our Website we have to make certain personal data available to our hosting provider, SiteGround Hosting Ltd., 3rd Floor, 11-12 St. James's Square, London SW1Y 4LB, United Kingdom. With respect to this so-called contracted data processing, these service providers are also

contractually bound to process your personal data for the same purposes as we do and in compliance with the respective data protection provisions (including the required security measures).

- 3.3. With respect to the further provision and processing of the services requested by you, especially the processing of your request, your Data may under certain circumstances also be transferred abroad. Please note that in foreign countries the retention, processing and transfer of personal data may be subject to other rules than those applicable in Italy. In such cases we will put in place the required contractual safeguards to ensure that any recipients abroad are bound by the same data protection standards.

4. Information, Correction and Deletion

You can request information about the Data stored about you at any time and free of charge at the contact points listed below. You can also request deletion, correction and restriction of processing or object to processing of your Data. Your Data will then be deleted or blocked immediately, unless there are legal storage obligations or legitimate interests on our part that outweigh your interests in individual cases; in these cases the data will be stored, but no longer processed until the storage obligation expires. In addition, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the responsible supervisory authority if you are of the opinion that the processing of the Data concerning you violates applicable law.
